CAMBRIDGE ENGLISH: ESOL SKILLS FOR LIFE

Cambridge English Language Assessment provides examinations in English for speakers of other languages.

Cambridge English: ESOL Skills For Life is a modular set of examinations based on the Adult ESOL Core Curriculum. They cover three units (Reading, Writing and Speaking and Listening), and are designed to assess English language competence through a variety of simulated authentic tasks. They measure performance at five levels on the Qualifications and Credit Framework, ranging from the lowest level of proficiency at Entry 1 through Entry 2, Entry 3 and Level 1, to the highest level at Level 2.

Successful candidates are awarded a 'Pass' grade. A Pass grade indicates that the candidate has achieved a satisfactory level of performance.

This is a Cambridge English: ESOL Skills For Life Award. Once a candidate has achieved a pass level for each of the three separate awards (Reading, Writing and Speaking and Listening) a Level certificate is awarded at the lowest level of successful achievement.

Candidates who pass the separate qualifications are awarded credit. The Cambridge English: ESOL Skills for Life Awards on the QCF have the following credit values:

- Speaking and Listening: 12 credits
- Writing: 9 credits
- Reading: 6 credits
